- **Worship**—to deepen our relationship with Christ and his Church, through prayer, mass and the sacraments.
- **Connect**—deepen our relationship with Christ’s body, one another, by getting to know each other better
- **Grow**—to deepen our spiritual life, our faith and knowledge of Christ through learning and spiritual growth opportunities.
- **Serve**—to deepen the image of Jesus in us by imitating him who came “not to be served but to serve.” To practice “acts of love.”

What you get from St Anne

What we first and foremost **have to offer you is the God revealed to us in Jesus** and as he comes to us through his body, the Church. We pledge to offer him to you **through opportunities, open to all, to worship, connect, grow and serve.**

- **Worship**—each week we offer Sunday Eucharist, the center of our life together, to encounter Christ in each other in the word and all the sacraments. We offer Daily Eucharist, monthly Eucharistic Adoration and evening prayer; we celebrate quinceañeras, Taize Prayer and other opportunities for ecumenical prayer. We offer an annual celebration of the Passover Seder. We commit to making Holy Week the three days (Holy Thursday-Easter Sunday) of the Lord’s passing from death to new life the center of our whole year. We commit to being people of personal prayer as well as people who pray together.

- **Connect**—each year we offer many different opportunities for us to gather as a community and family. Some events are fundraisers, others are purely social so we can deepen in our love and care for each other. These are also good times for us to connect with the larger community beyond members of our parish. We pledge to reach out to each other especially those who are new to the community.
- **Grow**—there are many ways to deepen our faith and love of Christ at St. Anne. We offer the process for becoming Catholic--Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA); Monday Family Faith Formation (K-adults), Preschool, Children’s liturgy of the Word 10:30 Mass on Sundays (K-5th grade) teen ministry. Special lecture series, parish renewal (mission) and Small Christian Communities (faith sharing). We also offer the opportunity to discover your personal gifts through the “Strength Finder” instrument.
- **Serve**—There are many different opportunities to serve in the various ministries of St. Anne Church. These are listed in the ministry booklet or online. We pledge to continue to offer these opportunities and we affirm any service which you render outside of the parish community.
