Nurses Notes

February is Heart Health Month

When too much cholesterol is in the blood, it builds up in the wall of the arteries, causing a process called atherosclerosis, a form of heart disease. This process causes narrowing of the arteries which then causes decreased blood flow to the heart. The blood carries blood oxygen to the heart and if there is insufficient blood and oxygen to the heart you may get chest pain. If the blood and oxygen supply is completely shut off this is called a heart attack.

There are 2 forms of cholesterol that most of us in the US are familiar with. 1) **LDL** is the **BAD** cholesterol. It is the main source of artery clogging plaque. The **good** cholesterol is called **HDL**. It actually clears cholesterol from the blood.

Recommendations

Ask your doctor how often you should be screened.

What do my results mean?

Total cholesterol should be < 200
borderline high is from 200-239
high is > 240

LDL cholesterol < 100 is optimal
100-129 is near optimal
130-159 is borderline high
160-189 is high
190 and above is very high

Note

If you have a condition such as Diabetes or if you have a heart condition or have already had a heart attack your recommendations may be stricter.

HDL : < than 40 is major risk factor and this increases your risk for heart disease. > 60 is desirable. This helps to decrease your risk for heart disease.
