Nurses Notes

February is Heart Health Month, Cont'd

Dietary guidelines

- Serve more vegetables, fruits, whole grains and legumes. These foods may be one of the most powerful strategies in fighting heart disease

Choose fats wisely

- Limit the total fat grams
- Serve the bare minimum of saturated fats and trans-fatty fats (for example, fats found in butter, salad dressing, sweets and desserts).
- Use fats that come non- animal sources such as avocado, nuts and oils such as olive, canola, and peanut.
- Serve a variety of protein foods. (the most common are meat and dairy products) but those are among the main causes of heart disease. Instead try lean animal, fish, and tofu

Eat regularly

- Skipping meals leads to overeating. By eating 5-6 mini meals you can help someone with heart disease control blood sugars, burn fat, calories more efficiently and regulate cholesterol levels.

De emphasize salt. this will help to control the blood pressure.

Encourage exercise,

- It strengthens the heart muscle and improves blood flow, reduces high blood pressure, raises HDL, and helps to control blood sugar and body weight. Consult your doctor before beginning a new routine.

Stop smoking.

Haven't we heard that before? Smoking a pack a day can triple your risk for heart attack in men and quintuples the risk in women!
