Nurses Notes

Summer is here and things are “Heating Up”

With the summer heat comes danger of:

1. Heat exhaustion, 2. Heat stroke (life-threatening) and 3. Dehydration. Signals of heat emergencies:

Heat exhaustion: Cool, moist, pale, or flushed skin. Heavy sweating. Headache. Nausea or vomiting. Dizziness, Exhaustion. **Treatment:** Get person out of the heat. Remove or loosen clothing. Apply cool, wet cloths. If conscious, give cool water. Have them drink slowly.

Heat Stroke: Hot, red skin. Changes in consciousness. Rapid, weak pulse. Rapid, shallow breathing. **Treatment:** Call 911. Move person to cooler place. Wrap body with wet cloths or towels. Fan the body. Watch for breathing problems and assist if needed with rescue breathing. Offer cool water if conscious. Keep person lying down until paramedics arrive.

Some things you can do to prevent these conditions:

1. Slow down. Avoid strenuous activity. If you must do strenuous activity, plan it for the coolest part of the day—early morning. 2. Stay indoors as much as possible. If air conditioning is not available, stay on the lowest floor, out of the sunshine. 3. Wear lightweight, light colored clothing. 4. Drink plenty of water regularly and often even if you are not thirsty. 5. Water is the safest liquid to drink. Avoid alcohol or caffeine. Beer can actually dehydrate the body. 6. Eat small meals and eat more often. 7. Avoid using salt tablets unless directed by a physician

PLEASE- Remember to use the office phone at St Anne, not a cell phone to call 911. Your cell phone will reach Sacramento CHP and precious time is wasted explaining where we are.
