Nurses Notes

October is breast cancer month

Overview

Often there are no signs of breast cancer, but, signs can include finding a breast lump or an abnormal mammogram. Among women, breast cancer is the most common cancer 2nd only to lung cancer. If 8 women lived to age 85, one of them would be expected to develop breast cancer at some point. 2/3 of women with breast cancer are > 50 years old and most of the rest are between 39-49 years. Experts feel that a 5 year survival, means a cure, although reoccurrences are common. Specifically, due to improved screenings and treatment options, 7 out of 10 women with breast cancer will survive more than 5 years after initial diagnosis, and, half will survive more than 10 years.

Early detection and treatment early in development remains the best strategy for better cancer outcomes.
