Sunday's First Communion Classes will meet Sunday, Nov. 28th.

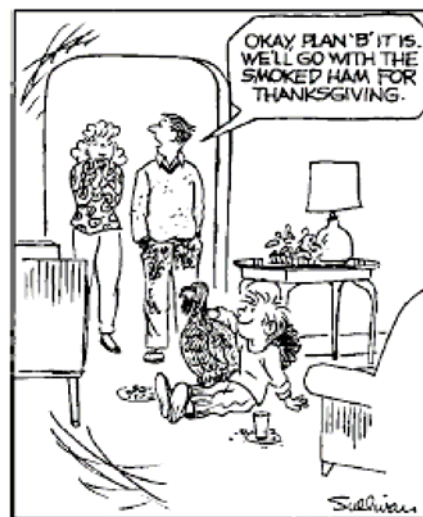

Nurses Notes

November is Diabetes month

Over the next few weeks I will discuss what is Diabetes, Pre - Diabetes, Type 1 and Type 2 Diabetes and treatment.

Type 1 diabetes

Type 1 diabetes occurs because the insulin producing cells of the pancreas (called beta cells) are destroyed by the immune system. People with Type 1 Diabetics produce no insulin and must use insulin injections to control their blood sugar. The symptoms of type 1 diabetes usually occur suddenly and can be severe.

They can include:

- Increased thirst
- Increased hunger (especially after eating)
- Dry mouth
- Frequent urination
- Unexplained weight loss (this is even though you are eating and are hungry)
- Fatigue (weak, tired, feeling)
- Blurred vision
- Labored, heavy breathing
- Loss of consciousness

You should talk to your doctor if you have these symptoms or in some cases the person may need to go to the emergency room. Blood tests can be done to find out if you have this type of diabetes. The treatment in this case is the use of insulin injections, dietary changes, and exercise. At some point other oral medications may be used.

PLEASE- Remember to use the phone in the office or at the AV area in the hall and not a cell phone to call 911. Your cell phone will reach Sacramento CHP and precious time will be wasted.
